Purple Polio Day

As part of our links with Bingley Rotary Club, the School Council have organised 'Purple Polio Day' on Friday 11th November where we will take part in a nationwide project to help eradicate polio. During the day, children are asked to come to school wearing something purple (t-shirt, skirt, leggings etc) for a donation (suggested donation of 50p); each child will have the opportunity to plant crocus bulbs outside the school, which will bloom in early spring.

The project enables the children to learn about what polio is, how it affects children and how raising funds can help to immunise children around the world and eradicate the disease forever. The purple crocus symbolises the purple dye that is painted on the little fingers of children to show that they have been immunised.
