Dear Parents,

I am hoping to take the children on a trip to Nell Bank, near Ilkley on **Thursday 15th June 2017**. This is an action packed day giving the children the opportunity to take part in a variety of problem solving activities. One of the activities will involve orienteering where they will work with a variety of maps in an unfamiliar environment. The children will also observe their surroundings, describe and compare physical and human features. This will enable the children to put in to practice the work they have covered in class in a practical way.

In addition the children will participate in a habitat trail where the children will practice team work skills and co-operation. They will need to listen to others and share ideas based on what they know about animals and their habitats. This trip will be a valuable experience for the children, having strong links to the expectations of the Science and Geography curriculum for Year 2.

The cost of this trip is £15 per child. This is made up of:

- Nell Bank entry fees £290
- Hire of an additional mini bus £68.25
- Fuel £33.75
- The total cost of the trip is £392 divided by 26 children is £15.07

Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead as planned. Deadline for consent and payment is Thursday 25th May.
