Dear Parents

We are always trying to find exciting ways to engage children in their learning, to incorporate this; we would like to take the class on a visit to Harewood House on **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October**. We will take part in their "Small Autumn Wonders" workshop which will give the children an opportunity to explore seasonal changes, work together on team projects (securing their new friendships) and produce some art work using natural materials. The session will be led by trained staff from Harewood House alongside staff from school. We will also have the opportunity to visit the bird garden and other areas within Harewood grounds whilst we are there.

The cost of this trip is **£14.67** per child which includes: Harewood House entrance fee, 'Small Autumn Wonders' workshop, coach travel & fuel.

We will be setting off from school straight after registration at 9am and we expect to be back in time for the end of the normal school day at 3pm (if we hit traffic or are running late, we will send a text to inform you).

Children in Reception and KS1 are entitled to universal free school meals and therefore the school kitchen can provide a 'packed lunch' that includes a choice of sandwich, piece of fruit, flapjack and juice carton. You can of course opt out of the provided lunch and make your own if you wish. Please visit the Reception class page of our website and at the bottom right hand side there is an option called 'Harewood House Lunch Choices' - please submit your child's lunch option for this trip (even if you intend to supply your own). All children will require a backpack to carry their own lunch.

Payment/consent is via ParentPay. Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and click on 'other items' the Harewood House trip will be listed. **Food & Consent/Contribution deadline is Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2019**. Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead.

On the day children will need to come to school in their outdoor PE kit and ensure that they bring a waterproof coat and appropriate clothing to keep them warm during a largely outdoor day.
