HOME LEARNING – Year 3

Reading	Continue to read at home. Read a selection of books including your reading book, library book and picture news (emailed weekly). Comprehension text are available on twinkl – see link for free resources (Search for LKS2 comprehension) Choose a book you have read and email me a summary of each chapter or a book review.		
Spelling/ Phonics	Continue to access purple mash spelling games and writing your spellings into full sentences. Practise your spellings using a variety of activities e.g. different colours, different sizes, backwards and forwards or in a pyramid.		
Maths <i>TTRockstars</i>	Arithmetic Write your own daily drilling (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). Remember to include missing number sentences and units of measure (£, cm/m).	Problem Solving Work through the activities provided showing your working out (mathswithparents; first4maths; whiterose) which will be emailed out.	
Purple Mash	We have set a number of '2do' activities that link with our current learning, that will consolidate and challenge work we have covered in class. Please also use this opportunity to explore the different tools on purple mash... create your own music, a book with attached sound or animation or even create an artistic masterpiece!		
Topic Menu World War II <i>(Linked to our current learning in class)</i>	Research World War II and focus on what preparations were made here (Homefront) and look at rationing/food sources. (Dig for victory) Using this information, you could create a presentation, film it and email it into school or produce a poster or fact file.	Feeling creative you could design a shelter, war plane and then make it into a 3D model. Design your own dig for victory garden. You could create your garden in a plant pot, flower box or even part of your garden.	Find out about an event during the war e.g. Outbreak of war, The Blitz, The battle of Britain. You can choose to present this information in a variety of ways for e.g. an information leaflet about keeping safe during the war or a scrap book.
Science Sound	Use 2animate on purple mash to create an animation showing how sound travels and how we hear.	Design and make a musical instrument. Then evaluate it – does it work? What kind of sound does it make? What worked well and what would you change?	Use 2sequece on purple mash to create a piece of music using different pitched instruments and experiment with changing the volume and speed.
