Changes to Payments

Payments can only be made via ParentPay and made in advance to the club commencing. ParentPay will only allow you to pay for a club up to the sign up deadline and then it will disappear from your menu. If a club becomes full, it will not allow you to sign your child up to it.

Charges differ for clubs each term due to the number of weeks in a term, materials required and depending on whether an extra member of staff is required. If clubs are facilitated by external sports providers these unfortunately tend to be more expensive. All payments for clubs also fund fuel and transport costs to various fixtures/festivals.

Places are allocated on a first come first served basis, some clubs fill up quicker than others, if a club is at full capacity, ParentPay will not allow you to sign up for the club. Some clubs require a minimum number of participants in order to go ahead, refunds will be issued if the club is cancelled. A place can only be allocated with payment. Your child is not automatically guaranteed a place, just because they have attended a club previously.

Info/Rules - Children can only attend a club if they have applied and been awarded a place. A confirmation text will be sent.

- Unsuccessful applications will have payment returned.
- All clubs must be paid for in advance. It will not be possible to attend a club if payment is not received.
- All clubs are for the number of weeks stated, children should attend every week. If your child is not attending for any reason, the office must be

informed. Payments will be for the term/half term and no refunds for any missed weeks (unless cancelled by HPS).

- All children in Reception, Years 1, 2 and 3 must be collected by a parent/carer at the end of the session, children in Years 4, 5 & 6 have the option of making their own way home at the end of the session or being collected by parents.
- When using the school/hired minibus some children will need to sit in the front seat. They will however be using the correct child car seat with back and neck support. If you do not want your child sitting in the front, please let the school office know.
- Any child not behaving appropriately may be asked to leave the club, parents will be informed but refunds will not be made.

How to sign your child up for a club

- 1). Visit www.parentpay.com and log in to your ParentPay account
- 2). Under your child's name, select 'Pay for other items'
- 3). The clubs available to your child will be listed
- 4). Select the club you wish to sign up to and select 'view'
- 5). Select 'Pay Full Amount' and 'Add to Basket'
- 6). If you would like to sign up for more clubs, please repeat the process.
- 7). When you have finished selecting all the clubs, go to 'Basket' and check out and pay.

There is no need to send an email or paper slip.

By paying for a club you are agreeing to abide by the terms and conditions of the club rules.

Activity Clubs are not open to Reception children until after Spring Bank.

KS1 Drama Club



We are pleased to announce that we have been awarded a small sum of money from the Bradford Opportunity Area : Essential Life Skills fund to create an opportunity for our children to take part in an exciting new drama club working with Monique Slattery from Musicular.

The drama club will run on a Monday from 3.00pm until 4.30pm in school. The drama club will be for children in Years 1 and 2 and will continue until summer. Hopefully, the drama club will showcase their performance to parents and visitors before the end of the summer term.

Monique has worked with KS2 over the past year on their memorable performance of Madagascar and has worked with a local stagecoach drama school for many years. Mrs Heseltine will be supporting our children at the club too.

Drama club will be great fun, playing drama games and learning new skills in acting, improvisation as well as singing and dancing. It's also great for developing skills in communication & expression, listening, problem solving well as giving you lots of confidence! Putting on a performance takes time & commitment from the children and, like Young Voices, we are asking that your child attends each week. This may be the first time your child has taken part in a drama club and with this in mind, we are offering a 2 week taster session, before we ask the children to fully commit. After this time, we expect your child to commit to the club until the end of the summer term.

A requirement of the Essential Life Skills fund is that the school monitors the impact of the club in a number of areas. In order to do this, we may ask you and your child for your input into our monitoring reports. Generally this will be in the form of question & answers/tick boxes.

If your child is interested in the drama club, please sign up via ParentPay. The club is on a first come first served basis and is limited to 20 places. Our first drama club will commence on Monday 29th April 2019.
