- Phonics Screening will take place in November.





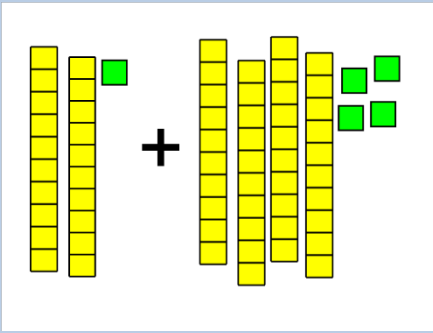

Suggestions for home



- Encourage children to write in pencil.
- Encourage children to re read what they have written to you.
- Ask children to help with daily jobs e.g shopping lists/reminders/writing a letter to family members.
- Use phonics to spell.
- Reinforce use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Practice letter formation.

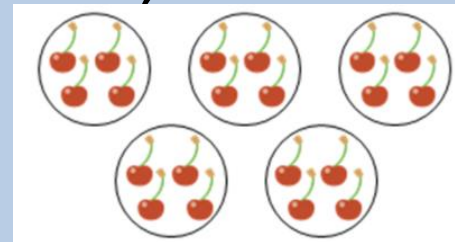

Suggestions for home

- Number formation- facing the right way, 2-digit numbers in the right order.
- Make it fun and practical – baking, pairing socks, sharing sweets/grapes equally.
- Counting (forwards and backwards) and 2s 5s and 10s
- One more and one less/10 more, 10 less language.

Suggestions for home

- Read every night/other night.
- Seesaw will be used to record reading.
- Aim for about 10 mins per session
- Read books to them.
- Discuss what they have read answer questions to show understanding.
- Talk about unfamiliar vocabulary.
- Encourage expression especially after developing fluency.

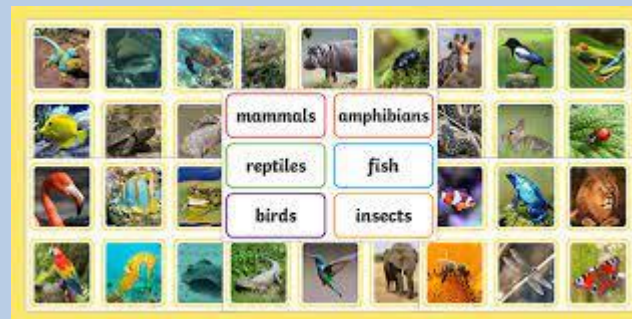


Science in Year 2
